- 1 Gatehouse/entrance
- 2 Feast your eyes in Lord Bute's brilliant banqueting hall, full of religious symbolism.
- 3 Be completely 'drawn in' by the spectacular decoration in the dramatic drawing room; spot the scenes inspired by Aesop's Fables.
- 4 No monkey business! Marvel at Lady Bute's bedroom; fit for a fairytale princess.
- 5 It's not a wind up! This working winch really does operate the portcullis.
- 6 Reach for the heavens! Climb the Well tower, to be rewarded by the stunning stained glass windows of Bute's long-lost chapel.
- 7 Explore the heart of the house through the kitchen with our plates that come to life and Lady Margaret's bedroom with its original thirteenth century furniture.
- 8 Discover the dark dungeon which is part Victorian, part medieval and very gloomy.
- 9 Enjoy a hot drink and a slice of cake in our recently refurbished tea room. Please do not eat or drink outside of the tea room.
